

Volleyball - Youth COVID Guidelines

Athletes/Coaches/Spectators

- All athletes when not actively playing, spectators, coaches, and officials are required to wear masks.
- Social distancing will be required throughout the facility and in the stands.
- No more than 2 spectators will be allowed per player per team.
 - o Children under the age of 2 are not included as spectators.
- Teams are asked not to arrive earlier than 15 minutes before their scheduled game time.
- Teams will be given a designated area for their team camp. Team
 equipment and affiliates will need to remain in the designated location if
 not leaving the facility between games.
- Officials are required to bring their own whistles. (Electronic whistles are encouraged, but not required)
- All participants, coaches, and spectators are encouraged to bring their own personal sanitizing products.

Equipment/Format/Facility

- Balls and other equipment will be sanitized between games.
- Brackets will not be posted at each facility to avoid crowding. Schedules and brackets can be found on the Iowa Games app.
- High touch surfaces will be sanitized throughout the course of the tournament.
- Teams will not switch sides/benches after each match.
- Restrooms will be available for use for handwashing.
- Medals will be available for pick up onsite for participants. If participants do not feel comfortable, medals can be mailed to them.

Participants and spectators are encouraged to check their temperature before arriving for their event. Iowa Games and their partners reserve the right to



check temperatures at any affiliated event. Individuals with temperatures exceeding 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit will not be allowed entry into the event.

If you or a member of your team or family have tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days, you are not permitted to participate in or spectate this event. If you or a member of your team or family have a pending COVID-19 test, you are not permitted to participate in or spectate this event.
