



Basketball COVID Guidelines

In accordance with Iowa State University's policies, the following protocols will be in place.

Athletes/Coaches/Spectators

- All athletes when not competing, spectators, coaches, and officials are required to wear masks.
- Social distancing will be required throughout the facility and in the stands.
- Spectators will be limited to 3 per player per team.
- Teams are asked not to arrive earlier than 15 minutes before their scheduled game time. Teams are asked to leave within 15 minutes of their game's completion.
- All participants, coaches, and spectators are encouraged to bring their own personal sanitizing products.

Equipment/Format/Facility

- Balls, scoreboards, and other equipment will be sanitized between games.
- Brackets will not be posted at the facility. Schedules and brackets can be found on the Iowa Games app.
- Tournament will be split into morning and afternoon sessions.
- Each division will initially be capped to limit the number of teams and spectators (division sizes may be adjusted based on entries)
- Number of courts in use simultaneously will be spread out, if possible.
- Spectators are encouraged to bring their own seating.
- Allow time between games for sanitization of equipment.
- High touch surfaces will be sanitized throughout the course of the tournament.
- Restrooms will be available for use for handwashing.
- Medals will be available for pick up onsite for participants. If participants do not feel comfortable, medals can be mailed to them.

Participants and spectators are encouraged to check their temperature before arriving for their event. Iowa Games and their partners reserve the right to check temperatures at any affiliated event. Individuals with temperatures exceeding 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit will not be allowed entry into the event.

If you or a member of your team or family have tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days, you are not permitted to participate in or spectate this event.

If you or a member of your team or family have a pending COVID-19 test, you are not permitted to participate in or spectate this event.
