

## Fencing COVID Guidelines

## Athletes/Coaches/Spectators

- Athletes, even while competing, coaches, spectators, and officials are required to wear masks while in the facility.
- Spectators will be limited to no more than 2 per athlete.
- Social distancing will be required throughout the facility.
- Athletes may not enter the facility more than 15 minutes ahead of their scheduled competition time and must exit within 15 minutes of their competition completion.
- Athletes are asked to leave the facility when not competing if not playing back to back. No congregating will be allowed.
- All participants, coaches, and spectators are encouraged to bring their own personal sanitizing products.

## Equipment/Format/Facility

- High touch surfaces will be sanitized frequently throughout the tournament.
- Equipment should not be shared, if possible. Equipment will be sanitized if needed.
- Locker rooms will be available for handwashing. Athletes should arrive dressed to compete.
- Medals will be available for pick up onsite for participants. If participants do not feel comfortable, medals can be mailed to them.

Participants and spectators are encouraged to check their temperature before arriving for their event. Iowa Games and their partners reserve the right to check temperatures at any affiliated event. Individuals with temperatures exceeding 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit will not be allowed entry into the event.

If you or a member of your team or family have tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days, you are not permitted to participate in or spectate this event.

If you or a member of your team or family have a pending COVID-19 test, you are not permitted to participate in or spectate this event.
