



Figure Skating COVID Guidelines

Athletes/Coaches/Spectators

- Facemasks must be worn by all participants when not competing, spectators, coaches, officials, and judges while in the arena.
- Social distancing is required throughout the arena.
- Skaters can check in no earlier than 30 minutes before their competition and no earlier than 15 minutes before their practice time.
- Participants will be asked to leave the arena between performances.
- Congregating within the facility will not be permitted.
- Each skater along with one parent or chaperone and one coach will be permitted in the facility, entering through the front door.
- Coach, spectator, and skater will be required to provide name, address, and phone number for tracking purposes.
- The time will be logged when the skater, parent, and coach enter the building.
- If you are coughing, have a fever, have a sudden loss of taste or smell, or in general do not feel well, please do not enter the building.
- All participants, coaches, judges, and spectators are encouraged to bring their own personal sanitizing products.

Equipment/Format/Facility

- High touch surfaces in the arena will be cleaned throughout the competition.
- Skaters should arrive in costume. Restrooms will not be available for changing.
- A competition schedule and any updates will be available online.
- Music should be sanitized before turned in.
- Medals will be available for pick up onsite for participants. If participants do not feel comfortable, medals can be mailed to them.
- Award blocks will not be available for pictures.

Participants and spectators are encouraged to check their temperature before arriving for their event. Iowa Games and their partners reserve the right to check temperatures at any affiliated event. Individuals with temperatures exceeding 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit will not be allowed entry into the event.

If you or a member of your team or family have tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days, you are not permitted to participate in or spectate this event.

If you or a member of your team or family have a pending COVID-19 test, you are not permitted to participate in or spectate this event.
