



Pickleball COVID Guidelines

Athletes/Coaches/Spectators

- Athletes, even while playing, spectators, and officials are required to wear masks.
- Spectators are limited to 2 per athlete.
- Athletes are asked not to arrive earlier than 15 minutes ahead of their scheduled game time. Athletes are asked to leave within 15 minutes of the completion of their game.
- Athletes are encouraged to leave the facility if not playing back to back.
- Social distancing is required by all participants and spectators.
- All participants, coaches, and spectators are encouraged to bring their own personal sanitizing products.

Equipment/Format/Facility

- Balls and other equipment will be sanitized before and after each match.
- All courts will be spaced more than 6-feet apart as well as the players' sitting areas.
- Hand sanitizer will be available in the facility as well as restrooms for handwashing.
- Players will not change ends of courts.
- Competition will be split into sessions to limit number of people in the building.
- Schedules and brackets will be spread out across the facility and available online to avoid crowding.
- Medals will be available for pick up onsite for participants. If participants do not feel comfortable, medals can be mailed to them.
- Award blocks will not be available for pictures.

Participants and spectators are encouraged to check their temperature before arriving for their event. Iowa Games and their partners reserve the right to check temperatures at any affiliated event. Individuals with temperatures exceeding 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit will not be allowed entry into the event.

If you or a member of your team or family have tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days, you are not permitted to participate in or spectate this event.

If you or a member of your team or family have a pending COVID-19 test, you are not permitted to participate in or spectate this event.
