



## HAPKIDO

### Technique Division

A pair of athletes will demonstrate a set of prepared Hapkido techniques that will be judged on **practicality, effectiveness, timing, execution, correct technique and presentation.**

In the **colored belt divisions**, the teams will perform techniques corresponding to pre-determined attacks (called for by the judges). Wrist, Shoulder, Pushing, Punching, Lapels, etc. In the **black belt division**, the competitors will choose their own attacks.

Competition will be organized in a bracket, with two teams facing off, and the winner moving on.

Mixed pair division both men and women can throw each other.

The first team (Team A) will demonstrate a technique, then the second team (Team B) will present theirs. The judges will then award a point to the best execution. This continues until each team has performed **4 techniques**. If necessary, there will be a 5th tie-breaker round. (In the colored belt division, this 5th technique will be a wild-card attack chosen by the judges.)

### Misc

- The tournament directors reserve the right to adjust the divisions based on the number of entries.
- The Hapkido Champion will be selected by total points earned during the Technique Demonstration.
