Supplementary Rules of Play:

Play is governed by the 2020 Rules of Golf of the United States Golf Association, the Iowa Section PGA Conditions of Competition Sheet and the following Supplement Rules of play, which apply to this golf course.

Please refer to Veenker's Special Local Rules for additional clarification.

FORMAT: 18-Hole stroke play for Boys 12-18 and Girls 14-18

9-Hole stroke play for Boys 11 & under and Girls 13 & under

TEE MARKERS: Boys 14-18 will play the GOLD Tees.

Boys 12-13 will play the WHITE Tees.

Girls and Boys 11 and Under will play the RED Tees.

Ball will be played Down.

Players are not to touch or remove flagstick.

Please hit a provisional ball for all no mow/fescue for potential lost ball unless marked as red penalty areas.

Notes:

SPORTSMANSHIP: Any player using foul language, throwing clubs or demonstrating any other type of poor sportsmanship may be disqualified.

PACE OF PLAY: Please see reverse side for Rule detail. Pace of play is very important and will be enforced. Players should be ready to hit when it is there turn, limit practice swings, finish short putts, play ready golf when at all possible, place their bag on the side of the green that is closest to the next hole, etc.

DOUBT AS TO PROCEDURE (RULE 20.1c (3)): Any player who is doubtful of his or her rights or procedure, may, without penalty play a second ball. The competitor should announce his intention to his marker or fellow competitor and notify them which ball he wishes to score with if the rule permits. The competitor must report the facts to the rules committee before returning his scorecard or he will be disqualified.

PERSONAL MEASURING DEVICES: RANGE FINDERS ARE ALLOWED, BUT MUST BE USED FOR MEASURING DISTANCE ONLY. PLAYERS WILL BE PENALIZED IF THEIR USE OF A RANGEFINDER IS FOR ANY REASON OTHER THAN DISTANCE. THE FIRST USE OF A BANNED RANGEFINDER FUNCTION WILL RESULT IN TWO STROKE PENALTY, AND ANY SUBSEQUENT USE DURING THAT ROUND WILL RESULT IN THE PLAYER'S DISQUALIFICATION.

TIES: Ties will be decided by a scorecard playoff beginning on the #1 handicap hole.

AWARDS: Awards will be provided and handed out as juniors are available, otherwise they will be mailed.

SIGNING AND RETURNING CARD: After completion of your round please return your scorecard immediately to the scoring area which will be located inside. There will be a designated area for each group to meet with a tournament official. Please verbally check that hole by hole scores are correct with marker and tournament official. The score is official and cannot be changed once the competitor has dropped into the scorecard box.

SPECTATOR POLICY: All spectators must keep at least 30 yards away from players at all times. However, they may carry water and umbrellas as well as help look for lost balls. **Spectators should try to keep even with or stay ahead of the groups as to not heed play of the group behind.** Members are not permitted the use of caddies in Junior Tour events and may not take advice or help of any kind.
